## Step 3: REGISTER Your Company to do Business with Government

- A. Must be Registered in System for Award Management: <a href="https://sam.gov/">https://sam.gov/</a>
  - a. Need to have your NAICS: <a href="https://www.census.gov/naics/">https://www.census.gov/naics/</a>
  - b. Need Your SAM Unique Entity Identification (required after 4 April 2022)
  - c. Commercial and Government Entity Program: <a href="https://cage.dla.mil/">https://cage.dla.mil/</a> (You will be assigned a Cage during SAM registration)
